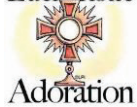

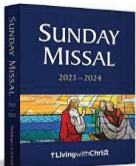
Once again, the statue of Mary

Reflection: In the Gospel, Jesus does not divide the world between Caesar (the emperor) and God. He does not throw us into confusion as our loyalty or allegiance to worldly powers and to God. What Jesus teaches us is that we have a responsibility to the State, to the political government. We must respect the political, temporal authority over us (Romans 13:1). But, more than anything temporal, our total obligation is to God who made heaven and earth. Coins, Caesar, Rome, plants, seas, mountains, sands, gold and everything in the world belongs to God. Jesus makes it clear that there should not be any enmity between God and the human state. The political leaders have their place and dues but God owns us all! Cyrus is a model for us today. God can use anyone to achieve His purpose – more so if we are better placed in society. We must make positive impacts just as Cyrus did. God's word today is a clarion call for Catholics and other Christians to participate in politics. If God can use a pagan king to do so much good, how much more can He use a believer, a Christian?
