VIRTUE OF THE MONTH - OCTOBER

During the month of October, our Catholic Schools are celebrating the virtue of FAITH for our faith is the foundation of who we are. Our faith brings us together for we share a common belief in God and in the gospel of Christ. We are rooted in the Catholic faith and as a community, express our identity through living out gospel values.
