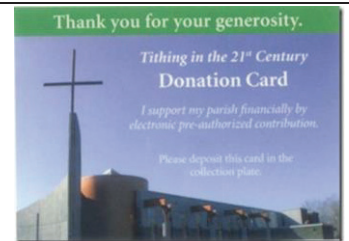
VIRTUE OF THE MONTH – OCTOBER

“And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.” Hebrews 11:6. During the month of October, our Catholic Schools are celebrating the virtue of FAITH for our faith is the foundation of who we are. Our faith brings us together for we share a common belief in God and in the gospel of Christ. We are rooted in the Catholic faith and as a community, express our identity through living out gospel values. Our faith must be manifest in three interconnected directions: spiritual growth, community building, and outreach. As a caring school community, we encourage our students to examine and evaluate their beliefs. We want them to make informed moral decisions, integrating faith with life. Please pray for our Catholic students; may they grow to become discerning believers formed in the Catholic faith community; effective communicators; reflective and creative thinkers; self-directed, responsible, life-long learners; and collaborative contributor who live their Catholic faith.

At Christ the King, it is our custom each year to have a special ceremony remembering, those deceased persons who have had Funeral Services through the parish during the one-year period of November 2nd to November 2nd. This year we will have a **Memorial Candle Lighting Ceremony** in the context of the 10:15 am Sunday morning Mass on **November 4th**. Following the homily, the names of each deceased will be read and a specially prepared candle will be lit and carried forward by a member of the family attending.



What is a PADP Donation Card? Many parishioners are finding the ease of maintaining their financial support of the parish by using the **Pre-Authorized Debit Program**. It means no need to write a cheque for the parish or find cash for the Sunday Offertory Envelope. Since parishioners who contribute automatically through the Banking System have no envelope to put in the collection...what will people think ... that you are not contributing? For this reason, a blue donation card has been made available to pick up at the main entrance. Parishioners who participate in PADP can pick up these and dropped in the collection basket during the Offertory Collection, as a sign they are donating electronically.
