**Please join us to Pray the Rosary every day before mass in the month of October.**



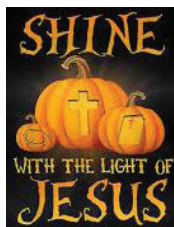
Once again, the statue of Mary graces the sanctuary during October, the month of the Holy Rosary. Rosary beads available at the door compliments of the CWL.

**Reflection:** Why would a Pharisee, a lawyer, an expert and a teacher of the Law ask Jesus which Law is the most important? It is because the Pharisees in their hypocrisy and self righteousness unnecessarily multiply and grade the commandments of God. It gets so

bad that the Pharisees build a legal system that made Israelites manifest their love in grades: God first and others follow in grades. That is why tax collectors, sinners, Gentiles, Samaritans, enemies are not loved; they are outside the grades of love. Jesus in one single breath summarizing all the commandments into: "love of God and neighbour" gives a new, shocking slant the traditional interpretation held by the Jews. He puts the love of God and neighbour on equal footing (1John 4:20). Thus, He teaches that the love of God and neighbour are inseparable. You can not claim you love God and hate your neighbour. The love Jesus teaches today is an all-inclusive love. A love that is committed to the good of the other. That "other" can be anybody or anything. This kind of love does not come naturally or easily; that is why we must 'will' it. It is an act of will. It is a conscious act in the name and for the sake of God. *'God's Word, Daily Reflections 2023.'*
