By reading up on the life of Saints I came across *Blessed Emilie Tavernier-Gamelin* from Montreal, she became a widow at 28 with three children and found great consolation in OUR LADY OF SORROW. This reminded me of the Feast Day of our Lady on September 15th and of the parish I belonged to on Manitoulin in Sheguiandah.

Emilie devoted the rest of her life looking after the poor and sick and under Bishop Bourget she established the *Sisters of Providence* in 1843. She died in 1851 and her last words were “humility, simplicity, charity, but above all charity”, Emilie was beatified in 2001.
