SAINTS' CORNER

Marie Elisabeth Turgeon (1840 -1881) ... Venerable Marie Elisabeth was elevated to "Blessed" in her cause of Sainthood on Sept. 17th on an account of a required miracle. A second miracle is needed for the next step to Beatification. Marie came from Beaumont in Quebec and died due to tuberculosis in Rimouski. Educated by the Ursulines, she began teaching in 1862 in St. Romould, later on Bishop Langevine of Rimouski asked her to help with the education of children in small, remote villages. Joining the Sisters of the Little Schools and taking the vows, she became the first superior in 1879. Ten years after her death the Order changed its name to "Sisters of Our Lady of The Rosary". http://www.soeursdusaintrosaire.org/index.php.






