Reflection: In the First Reading one can imagine the great disappointment that slaps the landowner after all his efforts in the vineyard. He does everything possible for the vineyard to yield grapes but it produces "useless" wild rapes. In the Gospel too, the landowner does everything right! He makes it a first-class vineyard- "a vineyard that gives the tenants every advantage". Yet, the tenants to whom he leases the vineyard are unproductive,

wicked and greedy. We are God's vineyard and are beautifully made to produce good fruit. The Jewish leaders who told this parable is originally told fail to produce good fruit. Instead of producing justice, they produce bloodshed; instead of producing righteousness, they produced distress. Therefore they are disenfranchised and the vineyard has passed on to the Church. We must know that the judgement of destruction pronounced on the original tenants is a warning to us, the new tenants. God is interested in people who will bear fruit for the Kingdom. *'God's Word, Daily Reflections 2023.'*
