watching what others are doing, James' letter says to be doers of the Word, and not hearers only. We all have moments when we get angry at the actions of others. When this happens, let us make the inward journey and ask ourselves: "What are the motives behind the person's actions that upset me? Do I ever exhibit the same motives in my own life?" 
