Reflection: Seeing beyond the flaws of others in order to behold the sacredness of God that dwells in them is a theme that we are invited to apply to our own lives.



The scribes and Pharisees complained that Jesus' disciples were not following the traditional rules for purity by washing their hands before eating. Jesus challenged them to reflect if they ever did things to get others angry by disregarding God's commandments, because they were clinging to human tradition. Instead of spending energy on watching what others are doing, James' letter says to be doers of the Word, and not hearers only. We all have moments when we get angry at the actions of others. When this happens, let us make the inward journey and ask ourselves: "What are the motives behind the person's actions that upset me? Do I ever exhibit the same motives in my own life?"
