## Reflection:

Today's readings are about the challenges that one would have to face if he or she holds on to faith. Our Christian faith is a challenge, because it is intrinsically connected with our life journey. Our faith is not merely about singing hymns and attending Sunday Mass. Our faith challenges our structures, relationships, our perspectives and us. Three such challenges can be located in today's readings. First, we have the personal challenge. Faith involves self-denial and suffering. Peter did not want to suffer, and the Lord reprimanded him. When we are in great love only with our own comfort, we will not take risks. Second is the communitarian challenge. Our faith is both personal and communitarian, and involves action. St. James speaks of action filled with love towards society. If our faith does not involve any action, it is a dead faith. Lastly, we have the intellectual challenge. Peter was taken aback emotionally; hence, he sought to rebuke Jesus. He was not able to see the larger picture or the bigger vision. Quite often, our vision is limited only to a narrow understanding of God through our reason, and we forget that God is bigger than our reason.
