Collection for the Needs of the Church in Canada: Why is there such a collection?

Every year, the Bishops of Canada makes an appeal for financial assistance to support their work and the work of each diocese by means of the Collection for the Needs of the Church in Canada. The Most Reverend Douglas Crosby, O.M.I., Bishop of Hamilton, has described this Collection as an invitation to "all the faithful to participate in the life and mission of the Church through their active involvement in the life of their parish community, their prayers, their diverse charisms, their moral support, and the contributions of their time and talents. The Collection for the Needs of the Church is an opportunity for Catholics to truly help their diocese participate in the regional episcopal assemblies and the CCCB. Any additional revenue which is raised is used by the diocese for its own pastoral programs and other activities." This Collection will take place on September 23 and 24, 2017.

GONFIRMATION

The sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated at Christ the King on Thursday, November 16, 2017 at 7:00 pm. Students who are in Grade 7 are eligible to receive this sacrament. Older students and young adults who may have missed an earlier reception of this Sacrament are welcome to participate at this time. Baptismal Certificates are required for all candidates. Attendance at four (4) preparation sessions to be held during October and November will be mandatory. Dates and times for these sessions will be determined shortly. RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

DESCRIPTION OF PROCESS: This process prepares adults for the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). It also prepares those adults who have been baptized in another faith for full Communion with the Catholic Church. Finally, it is an excellent opportunity for Catholics who want to update their understanding of the Church's teachings.

SCHEDULE: There are a total of 22 learning sessions held on Wednesday evening from 7:00 – 9:00 pm. beginning in November and ending in April. There are also periodic liturgical celebrations held at the regular Sunday Mass. If anyone is interested in participating in this journey of faith, please register by contacting the parish office.
