SAINT'S CORNER

This month's saint, Blessed Andre Grasset, was born in Canada but moved back with his parents to France after the Battle of Quebec. He and many other priests were imprisoned in the French Revolution era because they refused to sign the Civil Constitution of the Clergy. He died as a martyr in 1792 and was beatified with a large group of martyrs in 1926. He is also the first beatified Canadian; not long after that a College in his name was opened in Montreal. He was born in Montreal in 1758 after his parents came to New France in 1749.
