Reflection: *The ideal and the idle.* Our master becomes very concerned when He realizes His followers are idle. David's fall is a result of idleness (cf. 2 Samuel 11:1). Idleness does not only mean doing nothing, but as Paul writes in 2 Thess 3:11-12, some "do not keep busy but act like busybodies". Man is created to be

productive; that is who we are. When we do not engage in something positive, the devil engages our minds and eventually influences our actions. Hence the Master is trying to get each person to work in His vineyard no matter what time of the day it is; so long as it is day, man is called to be productive in his work, living an ideal (productive) life, not an idle life.
