**Reflection**: The necessity of suffering...These are some questions usually asked: Did the Son of God have to go through suffering and death for humanity to be saved? Why does God not just snap a finger to save us? After all, is He not God? Yet Jesus

Does it not answer the question of suffering despite a benevolent, all-powerful God? Peter's struggle is also our struggle: why must Jesus go through such suffering? In the human mind there are a thousand and one ways we can propose for our salvation and each of them does not involve suffering and pain. Yet God chose this one way. 


