Isaiah announces the good news of God's salvation that God is able to heal the blind, the deaf and the dumb. Jesus heals a deaf man who is also mute. God's promise is realised through Jesus. Drawing reference from the Gospel of Luke, at the beginning of His ministry, this was what Jesus set out to do when He declared. "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because He has anointed me to preach good news to the poor.

He has sent me to proclaim release to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind" (Luke 4:18). If we were taken to them literally, we will be left in awe of the miracle. Delving deeper, we are to examine our actions; perhaps we are the deaf and mute that Jesus wants to heal. When we listen to God's teachings, we are called to process the message God wants us to hear, to keep and apply His Word in our lives.
