

The second gift of the Holy Spirit is the gift of Understanding. In understanding, we comprehend how we need to live as a follower of Christ. A person with understanding is not confused by all the conflicting messages in our culture about the right way to live. We can know all kinds of things in the world but still have no understanding of the world or of the things. For example, I know that a rocket can send astronauts into space, but I have no understanding and how it all works together.

However, the gift of Understanding is better used in our relationships with God and with others. Trying to understand others is really a gift to them. We may not agree with them in fact we may strongly disagree with them but trying to understand using the gift of understanding opens us up to the possibility of thinking in a new way, of seeing the world through different eyes. In our relationship with God the same things hold true. We can't begin to understand the mind of God but we can pray that we understand God's actions and work in our lives. This helps us to see the world, others, and all creation, through the eyes of God.

Just think of the kindness and mercy of God who thoroughly understands us and tries to help us on our journey not judge us on our mistakes. Using the spiritual gift of understanding, we ask to see the world and others through God's eyes. We might be amazed at the compassion that God shows us and that we can show others if we see them through God's eyes. So often we just give up on others rather than try to understand. Again, understanding is not agreement. But it is being open to change.

Pope Francis explains that the Holy Spirit's gift of Understanding allows Christians to obtain *"intimacy with God"* and helps them understand things *"as God understands them."* Each morning as a reminder when I put on my glasses, I pray that God will help me to see things through his eyes and not my own. Understanding helps remove fears, fear of others and fear of God!

Trying to understand is work and to do so we really need the help of God to continue. The Spirit's gift of Understanding not only encourages us to understand the ways of God but also empowers us to do it. This really helps us when it comes to patients, patience with God, patience with others, and especially patience with ourselves. The more understanding we have of all three, the more at peace we can be in our lives in in our world.
