Friars Nook

Your faith has saved you. Go in peace" (Lk 7:50).

The whole meaning of Jesus' relationship with the woman is condensed in this statement that Luke puts into his mouth. Faith appears here in relation to love and the forgiveness of sins, as a confirmation that faith implies an attitude of conversion with respect to the offer of salvation that Jesus offers her. The woman, known in the city as a sinner, knows of Jesus' presence in the Pharisee's house and accepts through faith the offer of salvation that he implies for her. That is why Jesus lets her do it, not because he does not know that she is a sinner, but because in this way he gives her the opportunity for forgiveness. The Jewish woman of Jesus' time, without rights, eternally a minor, repudiated by her husband, confined to the house and with very few opportunities to maintain social contacts, kept away from the temple on certain days because of the laws of ritual purity and relegated at all times to a specially designated area for her in the temple and outside the atrium of the house of Israel, without the right to be taught the Law and without the right to be considered as a subject of the Law and therefore incapable of deserving, poor, sinful and small, found herself in a situation that constitutes her a significant paradigm of marginalization. And Jesus goes beyond her circle to approach her as well. While the Law denied women the right to teaching, Jesus brings the Good News to all and accepts and instructs women as disciples; When Jesus affirms the indissolubility of marriage, he is removing from the husband the privilege of the right of repudiation that he had (Mt 19:3) and when he announces that the obligation of fidelity is identical for both (Mk 10:11-12) he is underlining equality in unity.

Jesus tells them to "Go in peace," because their faith frees them from fear and the privileges of others, from the legal religious prescriptions that marginalize them and prevent them from being and feeling considered as a full person with the same access to God and the same capacity to deserve as the man, since, although no one can claim access to God based on their merits, the gratuitousness of the love of God, sovereign owner of his relations with humanity, wants the woman, like the man, to find herself in intimacy with Him.
