The Friar's Nook

The 7th gift of the Holy Spirit is Fear of the Lord. When I was a kid, my mother used the frequent phrase, "Just wait till your father gets home!" I think back on it now and what a terrible thing it was to do to my father because instead of being happy when he was home from work, I used to be afraid of what was going to happen once he got home. So, I would hide from him. The gift of Fear of the Lord is absolutely not that! My father used to think that Fear of the Lord was to be afraid of God and I can tell you from experience that God does not want us to be afraid of him. So, what is the gift of fear of the Lord?

Perhaps the word "fear" is wrongly used in this context nowadays and we should think about changing it. Like the church changed from Holy Ghost to Holy Spirit because ghost took on the connotation or something floating around with a sheet over it and that was not what the Holy Spirit was. The gift of the Spirit that is Fear of the Lord calls us to be in awe of God's greatness and humbly aware of our lowliness in comparison.

You cannot love something that you are afraid of. When we recognize the greatness of something in can engender fear but God only wants the best for us and so we have no reason to be afraid. But as we recognize and learn of the greatness of God we should be filled with awe. Oftentimes I find myself struck with the reality that God works in me and through me. These moments are extremely humbling for me to think that our great God would care about me and in fact use such a broken vessel to help bring about His goodness. I often joke that He must be really desperate to use me!

Pope Francis says about this gift: "This is Fear of the Lord: abandonment in the goodness of our Father who loves us so much." So, love and fear do not occupy the same space. We need to embrace true humility in the face of something so great. True Fear of the Lord is, "filial" that we are children of God and thereby we revere God and try to avoid separating ourselves from Him—as opposed to "servile" fear, whereby we fear punishment form Him. If we only live out our Christian lives our fear of being punished for what we've done wrong, then we aren't truly living a Christian life and loving as God would have us love. The love of God needs to be transformative in us that we may love in the way that Christ showed us, a self-giving love to God and to others.

So the Spirit gifts us with a sense of awe that we have a God so great and that he loves us to death and beyond.

NEW - Your Weekly Giving Report (from Fr. Bob)

In a spirit of continued communication and openness, you will notice a slight change in the way we will report various collections, as well as the breakdown of donations to St. Joan of Arc Parish. As you can see, our weekly collection is not keeping up with the pace of our everyday expenses which cannot be avoided. These are expenses that keep us operational. At present, our monthly expenses are approximately **\$31,500** (or \$7875 each week in a four-week month).

As we finalize a very minimal budget for 2025 and as you consider your commitments this year, we ask that you prayerfully consider increasing your weekly gift to the parish. We can't continue to do the powerful ministry work our parish is renowned for doing without your time, talent and treasure.

This week, we ask that you reflect on the idea of registering with the parish's Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG) program. Your participation guarantees safe, reliable and monthly support for us, especially when you are away for any period of time. In the weeks ahead, we will welcome a member of our Finance Committee who will share an important update about the financial health of our parish at all weekend Masses. We encourage you to pay special attention to their presentation and to begin lending your increased support in any way possible. *Thank you!*

We would like to thank all of you for a successful "Reaping Our Rights" fall campaign. We collected over 200 signed cards asking our federal government to Adopt mHREDD – mandatory Human Rights and Environmental Due Diligence. Your awareness and signatures ask that, "the Canadian government insist that Canadian companies assess the environmental and human rights impacts of their projects here and around the world." This weekend, we are also collecting your signed petitions asking the same of our federal government, which will be presented on Parliament Hill in May of this year. Thank you for your support!
