Friars Nook

In the Gospel of St. Matthew, Jesus invites us: "Learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart." This is the only time that Jesus proposes himself directly as a model. Furthermore, if the Beatitudes speak to us of Jesus himself, we must look to him to find out what it means to be meek. In Psalm 37, a land is promised to those who hope in the Lord, to the marginalized, those whom the Lord blesses, the honest, those who follow his path... They are invited not to despair, not to envy them, not to become exasperated, to repress their anger... because God will restore justice and put things in their place.

In other words, this message has to do with those who are sensitive to the presence of evil and injustice in the world. Jesus says: "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Learn from me, for I am gentle and humble, and you will be relieved, for my yoke is easy and my burden is light...»

Jesus, the gentle man, had to be born as an immigrant, not even having a place at the inn: during his life he had nowhere to lay his head; he died on a pole without a tunic or clothes: without anything. He was buried in a borrowed tomb. In the Resurrection, however, he will proclaim that «I have been given full authority in heaven and earth», that same earth that trembled and was torn at his death. He is the Lord of the universe. We learn to be gentle by being patient and full of hope in divine Providence.

As Gaudium et Spes 37 says: "The meek will be the masters of the world, for by using and enjoying creatures in poverty and with freedom of spirit, they truly enter into possession of the world, as one who has nothing and is master of everything."
