Friars Nook

The people seek Jesus because they find in Him something important for their well-being and their life. Man outside of revelation lives in dissatisfaction, he asks many questions, he searches. In the Gospel of St. John there appear people who search and question themselves: the disciples of the Baptist, the mother of Jesus, Nicodemus, the Samaritans, the crowd from Galilee, Mary and Martha, ... It reveals the universality of the search.

In the desert Jesus performed a sign of liberation: the multiplication of the loaves. According to rabbinical convictions, just as the first redeemer brought with him the manna, so should the second redeemer. This was precisely what the people expected. In the desert Jesus gave them the manna. The people saw in Him the prophet and wanted to proclaim him king. Jesus reciprocates with a gift those who seek Him. He rewarded the people with food. However, the search continued: the next day the people went to another place, to Capernaum. There Jesus recognized that the people were not looking for him because of the signs, or because he was the prophet, but because they saw their hunger satisfied. Then Jesus spoke to them of two kinds of food: that which perishes and that which gives eternal life.

«I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst. But I have already told you: you have seen me and you do not believe». He asked them not to act for the sake of perishable food, but for that which remains for eternal life. The one who gives the true bread from heaven is the Father of Jesus. This bread is given now and to this people. It has the three characteristics of manna: it comes from the hands of the Father, it is sent by him, it has come down from heaven and gives life to the world.

The word of God, which came down from heaven, is the bread of life. The only valid attitude towards this bread of life is faith in the person of Jesus.
