



JUBILEE YEAR – CORNER

Indulgences 3.0 – Pilgrimage Places

In the last few weeks, we have been discussing indulgences as one of the great graces of the Jubilee Holy Year of 2025. Jubilee Plenary indulgences can be obtained for oneself or for souls in purgatory. In 2025, there is a unique possibility of obtaining two plenary indulgences in one day. To gain a second plenary indulgence, one must apply the indulgence for the deceased and receive Holy Communion a second time that day within a Eucharistic celebration.

To obtain a plenary indulgence, the complete mitigation of the painful aspect of temporal punishment, the Christian must carry out a Papally chosen work that is especially spiritually healing and helpful. One such work is making a pilgrimage, a journey to a sacred site in order to draw closer to God. What pilgrimages are being encouraged this year?

I. Go to Rome! The traditional work in a Jubilee Year, a Holy Year, is to make a Pilgrimage to Rome and to experience God's personal love by passing through a Holy Door in any one of the Four Major Papal Basilicas (St. Peter's Basilica, the Archbasilica of St. John Lateran, St. Mary Major, or St. Paul Outside the Walls) You can also visit any of the special Jubilee churches listed by the Apostolic penitentiary in Rome.

II. Make a pilgrimage to another Sacred Site in the Holy Land or Italy: Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi, Basilica of Our Lady of the Angels in Assisi, Basilica of Our Lady of Loreto Basilica of Our Lady of Pompeii, Basilica in St. Anthony in Padua, OR in the Holy Land: Basilica of the Holy Sepulcher in Jerusalem, Basilica of the Nativity in Bethlehem, Basilica of the Annunciation in Nazareth.

III. Make a local Pilgrimage and say special prayers in a special Toronto church. The main site is St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica, Toronto. But there are other locations.

- Central Region: St. Paul's Basilica, St. Mary's, (Bathurst Street), St. Edward the Confessor Parish, North York,
- Western Region: Our Lady of Sorrows, Etobicoke, St. Mary's, Brampton,
- **Eastern Region**: St. Barnabas, Scarborough, St. Gregory the Great, Oshawa;
- Northern Region: St. Padre Pio, Kleinburg, St. Mary's, Barrie;
- Shrines: Martyrs' Shrine, Midland

IV. Make a "pilgrimage" to Christ, even daily, for an appropriate amount of time, present to His brothers and sisters (cf. Mt 25, 34-36) who are in need or in difficulty (the sick, prisoners, lonely elderly people, disabled people...)
