#### **BLESSED SEBASTIAN VALFRE**

"When it is all over you will not regret having suffered; rather you will regret having suffered so little, and suffered that little so badly."

BI Sebastian was born on March 9, 1629 to a humble and poor family. He remained poor throughout his life in the Congregation of the Oratory at Turin. At the Oratory he wished simply to serve the people of God in whatever capacity he was given, whether in pastoral work, house administration, scholarly pursuits, or sweeping the stairs. He would as happily go to the death beds of the poor or the Royal family of Savoy. Most of his life was spent wandering around the streets and squares simply being available, speaking of God's love for all men and of the love that we should have for each other.The Apostle of Turin died on January 30, 1710. He was beatified by Pope Gregory XVI in 1834.

#### JUBILEE YEAR - CORNER

#### Indulgences in 2025? - What is an Indulgence? Part 2

Nothing unclean can enter heaven. We need forgiveness for both sin and the negative effects of sin. Think of King David. After King David committed adultery, after he had Uriah killed, he went on to marry and have a child with Uriah's wife. This action went against God's will and caused much harm to David and many others. David eventually repented of his sin and was forgiven, but he still had to undergo a painful process to counterbalance his own evil choices and the consequences of his sin (2 Samuel 12). King David had to be cleansed of what the Church calls the temporal punishment due to sin. He fasted. He did penance. He suffered loss.

As David underwent "reparative punishment after forgiveness" (Pope St John Paul II), we too must be cleansed of all the negative effects of sin. For such cleansing, we need both to undergo something painful, something we do not like, and to perform actions that heal our wounded souls. Like a loving Mother, the Church has realized she has a special way to encourage really healing (medicinal) activities in her children in this life. She attaches an indulgence, a forgiveness of the temporal punishment due to sin.

In an indulgence, the Church asks God the Father, "to mitigate or cancel the painful aspect of punishment by fostering its medicinal aspect through other channels of grace" (Pope St John Paul II). A partial indulgence mitigates the painful aspect of purgatory. A plenary indulgence cancels it completely! In this Jubilee Year, the Church has many ways to obtain indulgences for ourselves or those who have died. We will be highlighting them in the upcoming weeks. Indulgences speed up the soul's release from purgatory. How many deceased members of our parish would repay us in heaven for helping them! Let us seek to gain many indulgences this year for St Vincent's parishioners in purgatory. Let us ask them to pray for our parish when they get to heaven!
