Sunday, February 16, 2025 Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time From Fr. Rob.....



Having called His first disciples in last Sunday's Gospel, Jesus now turns to teaching them about what discipleship means. In Luke's version of the Beatitudes, part of the Sermon on the Plain (Matthew has Jesus on the mountain) Jesus lays out the demands of discipleship. Luke lays out both blessings and woes. He does this to lay out the existential choice that is involved in following Jesus. We can either put our trust in the Lord or we can trust in ourselves. Today's psalm invites us to remember "Blessed the one who trusts in the Lord."

Discipleship is about making an act of faith. Each day provides opportunities to pray about how the Lord is working in our lives and inviting us "to put out in the deep for a catch." Jesus show us the way. Our job is to follow. May these next couple of weeks deepen our resolve to get our discipleship on firm foundation so that when we hear the Lenten call to renewal in March we will be ready!



LITURGICAL NOTES FROM LAST WEEKEND

- 1. Remember to embrace silence throughout the liturgy in the times provided.
- In the Creed, we make a small bow as we say the words: "who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary (Apostles Creed); "and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man." (Nicene Creed)
- 3. Preparation of the gifts: all stand as the celebrant finishes washing his hands and turns back towards the congregation to offer the invitation "Pray sisters and brothers...
- 4. After singing the Lamb of God, all kneel to hear the invitation "Behold the Lamb of God..., we respond Lord I am not worthy..." When we have said this, all stand to prepare for the Communion Rite. The priest will then receive communion, and the communion procession begins. All remain standing until the procession lines are finished. Then we can kneel or be seated. We do not wait until the Blessed Sacrament is placed in the tabernacle.
- 5. Those bringing communion to the homebound are to receive communion first, then present the communion pyx to the minister.


