## Sunday, January 19, 2025 Second Sunday in Ordinary Time From Fr. Rob.....



In today's Gospel, Jesus and His disciples are invited to a wedding in Cana. Jesus performs the miracle of turning water into wine. All are amazed. What Jesus shows is tremendous sensitivity to a troubling situation while at the same time showcasing the generous nature of the Father. It is not just ordinary wine but the best wine. God does not withhold the best of anything from us. God is compassionate and generous. But notice how Mary also plays a part in this event. She intervenes and tells the servants "Do whatever he tells you." She is reminding us of the first step in discipleship: listening to and following Jesus. When we do this, it leads to abundance.

Paul in his letter to the Corinthians speaks of abundance when speaking of the gifts of the Spirit. God sends these gifts as a way of helping all of us live a holy and righteous life. God sends the gifts we need: all different and all allocated in a variety of ways in order to help all of us live out our discipleship.

Next weekend marks the observance of the Sunday of the Word of God. Pope Francis instituted this observance on the 3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time as a way for all of us to reflect on the importance of God's Word in our lives. One simple suggestion: come next weekend prepared to listen intently as the readings are proclaimed and take home with you one word or sentence that really hits you in your heart. Then meditate on that for the following week and ask: What is God saying to me in these words?
