Sunday, January 26, 2025 Third Sunday in Ordinary Time From Fr. Rob.....



Today is the Sunday of the Word of God. Pope Francis instituted this special observance at the beginning of the Season of Ordinary Time in order to place a special focus on the importance of God's Word. Our discipleship is rooted in the Word-Jesus, the Word Made Flesh. As we listen each week to the scriptures, our hearts are open to hear what God is saying to us.

In the first reading, the scribe Ezra calls the people together and reads from the Book of the Law. We hear: "the ears of all the people were attentive to the Book of the Law." It had a profound effect on them as they listened because they were hearing about God's covenant relationship with them and their responsibility to live it out.

Jesus in the Gospel stands in the synagogue and reads from the Prophet Isaiah. Of course this reading points to Him. Upon finishing, Jesus says "today this reading is fulfilled in your hearing." The people have a personal encounter with THE WORD. Each Sunday as we gather, we encounter Jesus as He speaks to us. God's word strengthens, uplifts, challenges, consoles and inspires hope.
