LITURGICAL REMINDER: There remains some confusion. After singing the Lamb of God, all kneel to hear the invitation "Behold the Lamb of God..., we respond Lord I am not worthy..." When we have said this, all immediately stand to prepare for the Communion Rite. The priest will then receive communion and the communion procession begins. All remain standing until the procession lines are finished. Then we can kneel or be seated. We do not wait until the Blessed Sacrament is placed in the tabernacle.
