Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Monday, December 9 (transferred from Dec 8 in 2024). In the 13th century ... St. Bernard and St. Thomas Aquinas debated whether Mary could have been born with original sin if, as St. Paul says, all persons are born in sin (Rom 5:12). ...the theological debate was resolved in 1854 by Pius IX who defined the doctrine of the Immaculate Conception as a dogma of faith. (livingwithchrist.ca)

The Immaculate Conception is not to be confused with the virgin birth of Jesus. The dogma states: 'The most Blessed Virgin Mary was, from the first moment of her conception ... by virtue of the merits of Jesus Christ ... preserved immune from all stain of original sin.'

Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe Thursday, December 12, Mass at 12:15 pm

Today's memorial commemorates the apparitions of the Blessed Virgin in 1531 at Tepeyac, on the outskirts of Mexico City. Our Lady appeared four times, twice to aboriginal convert Juan Diego, with whom she left orders to build a church and an imprint of her image on a cloak. This cloak an object of great veneration, is preserved in the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe. (livingwithchrist.ca)
