59 - 1

When Jesus, the very presence of God, is brought into the Temple, no one recognizes the significance of that event except Simeon and Anna. Both of them were righteous people and filled with the Spirit of God. As we are told, "**the Holy Spirit rested on Simeon**" and Anna "**never left the temple but worshiped there.**"

Simeon and Anna recognized God's presence because they made themselves present to God. We do not pray to make God present to us; God is already present in our lives. We are invited to make ourselves present to God. We do so by walking in His ways and being open to the mysterious ways He acts in our lives.

THE FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD, February 2nd

Today's feast commemorates the day when Jesus was brought to the Temple by Mary and Joseph. This event stands as the fourth Joyful Mystery of the Rosary... In the Middle Ages, a tradition began of blessing candles and holding a procession of light on this day.
