# Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary Thursday, November 21<sup>st</sup> Mass at 12:15 pm

An apocryphal source recounts that Mary's parents brought their three-year-old daughter to the Temple in Jerusalem to offer her to God, as was the custom. Inspired by a priest's vision, they left her there to serve God. ... The feast entered the Western calendar in 1585. Today, the feast celebrates the recognition of Mary as a temple where God lives.
