Weekly Gospel Reflection (Mk 10: 35-45)



James and John seek for places of honor in Jesus' glory, so the Lord asks them a question, "**Are you able to drink the cup that I drink?**" Since the metaphor of the 'cup' represents the Lord's Passion, the disciples are told figuratively that sharing Jesus' glory is possible only through sacrifice of one's very self for others.

In this way Jesus explains that to be close to God and to have the place of honor in His Kingdom is to be close to people and to be attentive to their needs.

Saint John Paul II Tuesday, October 22, Mass at 7 pm

Karol Józef Wojtyla, known as John Paul II since his October 1978 election to the papacy, was born in Poland in 1920. ... His love for young people brought him to establish the World Youth Days. ... The attendance of Pope John Paul II for World Youth Day 2002 in Toronto was the third official visit of the Holy Father to Canada. More than 800,000 people crowded Downsview Park for the closing Papal Mass on July 28, 2002. ... John Paul II is patron saint of [youth, families, and] World Youth Day (*Living with Christ*).

Join us for Mass, and Exposition of the First-Class <u>Relic of the Saint</u>. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament follows the Mass.
