**JUBILEE YEAR - PILGRIMS OF HOPE:** Pope Francis has declared 2025 a Jubilee Year. The theme is "Pilgrims of Hope." The Jubilee began on December 28, 2024 and ends on January 6, 2026. Here is the official prayer issued by Pope Francis for it:

### THE JUBILEE PRAYER

Father in heaven, may the faith you have given us in your son, Jesus Christ, our brother, and the flame of charity enkindled in our hearts by the Holy Spirit, reawaken in us the blessed hope for the coming of your Kingdom.

May your grace transform us into tireless cultivators of the seeds of the Gospel. May those seeds transform from within both humanity and the whole cosmos in the sure expectation of a new heaven and a new earth, when, with the powers of Evil vanguished, your glory will shine eternally.

May the grace of the Jubilee reawaken in us, Pilgrims of Hope, a yearning for the treasures of heaven. May that same grace spread the joy and peace of our Redeemer throughout the earth. To you our God, eternally blessed, be glory and praise for ever. Amen

**NEW SUNDAY MISSALS 2024-2025** are now available for purchase at \$5 each. These Sunday Missals contain the readings from the 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of Advent (December 1, 2024) to the Feast of Christ the King (November 23, 2025). Missals can be purchased by picking one up at the front of the church and using the envelopes provided (exact change only), or from the parish office.

BELL TOWER MAINTENANCE: A detailed report on the physical status of Parish's buildings and exterior areas has been prepared by a professional engineering company. The report includes assessments of specific areas, systems and equipment based on visual observations and measurements in some cases. The Finance Council has discussed the recommendations included in the report. The Bell Tower is showing signs of aging and water damage. It will be the first of a series of maintenance initiatives over the next decade. The Bell Tower Sub-Committee of the Finance Council (Paul Hession, Bev Binette, Brian Gracie, Paul Gravelle) is currently creating a history of the Tower's original construction and its maintenance over the years. The group is also researching and identifying possible service providers. Parishioners will receive regular updates as the project progresses, including the projected costs of several possible options.
