



#### Update: Holy Family Catholic Church, Sauble Beach

"I have chosen and consecrated this house, says the Lord, that my name may be there forever" 2 Chr 7:16

Holy Family had a very busy year, re-opening in April 2024. As reported earlier in the bulletin, the interior renovations, after the successful removal of the black mould under our peaked roof, were both physically and fiscally done in a responsible way, with no outstanding debt.

Our beautiful church welcomed our permanent members, seasonal parishioners and many visitors who came to the beach. The pews were full with active participation in the celebration of the Mass, in joyful prayer and song. We received many compliments on how bright and welcoming our church was.

The black mould forced us to focus on the interior of Holy Family Church first. Once the heaters were rewired, the new fans installed (G & M Electrical) and our audio system (which is currently being shared with St. Mary's of the Rosary, Hepworth for the winter months) and the microphones adjusted (Taylor Electronics), we turned our attention to the exterior needs. If we didn't do some work in this area our interior repairs were in jeopardy.

Three areas were addressed: resurfacing the 25% of the flat roof and entrance canopy (not done in 2016 when the rest of the flat roof was done), replacing two windows that would not close properly and had broken seals, and repairing or installing new eavestrough, soffit and facia around the exterior of the church roofline and canopy. Several companies were contacted to submit proposals, and the renovation committee selected the tenders of DJ Peat (Annan), Van Dolder's (Owen Sound) and Staubitz Contracting (Sauble Beach). All repairs are now completed, and we are ready for winter.

Due to the success of our summer Building Fund envelope program, the generosity of our congregation, as well as, the much-needed support of the Ex Corde Foundation, Hamilton Diocese (\$25,000.00 as reported in the Nov. 6 bulletin) we were able to accomplish all of the required exterior work at Holy Family with no debt to St. Mary's or any of the mission churches.

Holy Family feels blessed! We have a true sense of pride and accomplishment in doing what was necessary, both in the interior and exterior of the church, and we feel confident that the church is in excellent condition now and for the future. Many thanks to all who helped financially to make this possible. A special thanks also to members of the renovation committee for their personal contribution of time, material and talents.

We look forward to celebrating our 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary in July 2025. More details will be shared in the bulletin as we plan this special event. We hope you can join us as we rejoice in the house of the Lord!


