St. Peter & the Missions Walking Pilgrimage to Martyrs' Shrine 2024 - St. Peter & the Missions is doing a walking pilgrimage from St. Joseph's, Markdale to Martyrs' Shrine, Midland in August. The pilgrimage will be supervised by Fr. Grayson Hope, and other leaders. There will be daily Mass, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, Rosary, and other prayers. We meet at St. Joseph Church in Markdale for Mass on Monday, August 5, at 10:00am. After Mass we will begin the walk. We will arrive at Martyrs' Shrine in Midland on the afternoon of Thursday, August 8. We will stay at Martyrs' Shrine overnight. On Friday, we will walk to St. Ignace, the place of martyrdom of Sts Jean de Brebeuf and Isaac Jogues, and celebrate Mass there at 12 noon, followed by a lunch. Parishioners and others will join in for the final Mass. We depart for home, or for those who want to stick around, they can tour Sainte-Marie among the Hurons, and Martyrs' Shrine. 4th World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly, July 28th – This special day, initiated by Pope Francis, is a precious opportunity to value grandparents and the elderly in our local communities. This year's theme, “**Do not cast me off in my old age**” (Ps 71:9), highlights the loneliness experienced by many elderly people. In a world that increasingly sends a message that the elderly do not matter, we are called to let them know they do and that we recognize their worth.

Attending to our grandparents and the elderly is not only a sign of gratitude and affection, but a necessity in the construction of a more human and fraternal society. The Holy Father invites us to recognize their value and to do so permanently, not just occasionally. It is not a matter of celebrating an anniversary once a year, but of making the elderly feel like an integral part of our Christian family and our common history.
