



# Report from Holy Family Catholic Church, Sauble Beach

#### June 29-30, 2024 Bulletin Update

As published in the April bulletin, Holy Family Catholic Church, Sauble Beach underwent a major, but necessary, renovation this winter. Black mould was identified and removed from the entire ceiling area under the peaked roof - an area of almost 2,500 square feet. We tendered contracts for all trades. After the mould removal, we proceeded with the construction of new centre beams and drywall installation which included a new vapour barrier, boarding, R60 insulation, taping, mudding, sanding & painting. We passed all building inspections by the municipality of South Bruce Peninsula. The electrical needs of the church were brought up to code: the old was removed and new wiring, LED lights, fans, and speaker wires were installed. The old heaters were rerouted, and a new central thermostat added. As well, a new sound system, including speakers, transformers and microphones, was installed to replace an outdated system. Our final step was professional cleaning of all carpets, after the construction was completed. Committee members and volunteers helped clean pews and refresh other areas of the church in preparation for the official re-opening.

Fran Craig attended the St. Mary's and the Mission's Finance Committee meeting on May 29/24. Fran related the details of the project to the members and Amy Harrison, bookkeeper, also reconciled our account. It is with confidence and pride that we share these broad stroke expenses and methods of payment.

#### Expenses included:

Mould Removal (Ontario Mould Specialists) \$29,000.00 Electrical Needs (G & M Electrical Mechanical) \$12,000.00 Construction Needs (Schmidt's Contracting) \$35,000.00 Audio System Needs (Taylor Electronics) \$8,500.00 Rug Cleaning (Weiler's & O-KAY Cleaning) \$1000.00 Committee Needs (primer, paint, ceiling replacement tiles, stain & verathane, building permit, Mor-vents, dimmer switches, etc.) \$1000.00

Total Costs: \$86,500.00

#### Revenue included:

Holy Family Building Fund (December 2023) \$40,000.00 Ex Corde Foundation Grant, Hamilton Diocese (May 2024) \$40,000.00

New Building Fund Envelopes (April – May 2024) \$7,000.00 Total Revenue to apply to the Costs: \$87,000.00

We are debt free on the project, but we are still in need of donations to ensure that not only this work, but the future needs of Holy Family Church can be taken care of in a fiscally responsible way. As with any older building, maintenance is an ongoing task. Three outstanding items: a window replacement, resurfacing of the canopy and a small section of the flat roof and soffit, fascia and eavestrough repair, need to be addressed to keep the inside renovations protected. We will be using the special Building Fund envelopes throughout the summer in the hopes that people

will be generous, and we can complete these items and replenish the Building Fund for future needs.

Thanks be to God, Holy Family Catholic Church is once again a clean and healthy space for us to come together, to pray, and celebrate Mass. Please come and visit our beautifully restored church over the summer months. Everyone is welcome! Holy Mass is at 9 a.m. each Sunday. See you there!


