The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a Minor Basilica by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's Coat of Arms presents a shield sheltered by the ombrellino, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin every eye shall see him.

GETTING MARRIED AT THE CATHEDRAL

Couples who are planning to marry at the Cathedral Basilica in 2026 should be in contact with us now. We ask one year's notice of marriage to complete the various components of the marriage preparation requirements. One party to the marriage must be Roman (Latin Rite) Catholic. Both parties must be free of any prior bond of marriage (civil or religious marriage). Couples must reside in the Diocese of Hamilton. Only the Rector of the Cathedral, or his delegate, preside at the celebration of marriage in the Cathedral. Our Parish's website ctkbasilica.ca has information about getting married under the Sacraments tab. Couples should read the document and complete the Application for Marriage and then contact our Office for an appointment. At no time will we discuss possible dates by telephone or email. Only the bride or groom should contact the Parish Office for an appointment. We are not able to make appointments through a third party - wedding planners or parents.
