WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin *every eye shall see him.*

ORDINARY TIME

This Sunday's feast of the Baptism of the Lord concludes the Christmas Season. The Church begins the Season of Ordinary Time on Monday, January 13. This Season has two parts. The first eight weeks before the start of Lent (March 5); and then resumes on the Monday after Pentecost. Each Sunday is numbered (ordinals - Ordinary). We will hear from Luke's Gospel at the Sunday liturgy. The evangelist, Saint Luke, wrote for a largely Greek community of Jews and new believers. He is the author of the Gospel and the Acts of the Apostles. Green is the liturgical colour for the Season. It is a sign of the hope that is the hallmark of this time and of our Christian lives.

VATICAN II - STUDY SERIES

Today's bulletin includes information of a wonderful opportunity for parishioners to study the four major Constitutions of the *Second Vatican Council*. This video study series has been prepared by the Diocese for our reflection as the Holy Year of Hope begins. The series begins next Wednesday, January 22 and runs for 5 weeks. Plan to join us.

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, March 5, 2025. Easter Sunday is April 20, 2025. Lent is a wonderful time for prayerful reflection, excelling in charity, and a renewal of interior penance. Our annual Lenten Retreat will begin on **February 26** with a video series and small group discussion. **The Creed** is a series by Bishop Robert Barron, and we are happy to feature it this Lent. Join us too for *Stations of the Cross* on the Fridays of Lent beginning March 7. Always good to plan ahead!

EXTENSION FOR 2024 DONATIONS

During the Christmas Break, the Federal Finance Minister announced an extension of the deadline for Charitable donations from December 31 to the end of February. The Cathedral Parish is a federally registered charity and so donations can be accepted during this period and qualify for a 2024 income tax receipt. This extension is offered in response to the Canada Post strike. For the Cathedral Parish, all donations (except loose offerings) received in 2024 will receive a 2024 receipt in late January. Donors who designate a donation for 2024 will receive an additional receipt for 2024. NOTE: Donations given using 2025 offering envelopes will be credited toward a 2025 receipt.



IUBILEE VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

The Cathedral Basilica has been designated as a pilgrim Church in the Diocese of Hamilton. As such, we will require some volunteers to assist with hosting responsibilities throughout the year. These Jubilee Volunteers will assist us on the four "Pilgrim Sundays" – February 2, March 30, October 19, and November 23. Volunteers will serve as greeters and assist with stamping pilgrim prayer books.
