## **WELCOME!**

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin *every eye shall see him.*

The joyful Season of Advent begins on December 1. Advent begins a new Liturgical Year and helps us prepare for the great feast of Christmas – the birth of Jesus. The coming Liturgical Year (C) will feature the Gospel of Luke on most Sundays of Ordinary Time. A good way to journey through Advent would be to read parts of Luke chapters 1 and 2 – the infancy narrative. In Advent we fervently pray – *Marantha!* – Come, Lord Jesus, come!

#### CHRIST THE KING

Happy Feast Day! Christ the King was chosen as the Patron of our Parish by Bishop John T. McNally who served as the fifth Bishop of Hamilton (1925-1937). The feast of Christ the King had been established by Pope PiusXI in 1925 as a Christian response to the rise of fascistic and communistic governments in Europe. Christ's kingdom is one of justice, mercy and peace. Christ the King offers us the model of Christian service and leadership in the washing of feet. All of us are called to imitate this model of servant-leadership in our daily lives. Like Christ, we are called to open our hearts in love and our hands in service to others, especially the poor and those on the peripheries. May we be worthy of Christ our King!

#### WORLD DAY OF YOUTH

World Youth Day is observed in Dioceses and Parishes around the world today. WYD was instituted by Saint John Paul II in 1985. International gatherings have been held since then every three years. In 2027, WYD will be celebrated in Seoul, South Korea. Pope Francis continues to encourage the youth of the world, "Young people must say to the world: It is good to follow Jesus! You bring us the joy of faith and tell us that we must live the faith always with a young heart." Let us pray for all youth on this day – particularly those who are burdened with sadness, uncertainty and doubt.

The Jubilee Year begins with the opening of the Holy Door in Saint Peter's Basilica at Christmas Midnight
