#### **WELCOME!**

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin *every eye shall see him.*

#### SYNOD ON SYNODALITY

The Synod of Bishops reflecting on *synodality* as a way forward for the Church has concluded its meetings in Rome. This model offers a template for the Church at various levels to listen to various voices – even those on the peripheries – as we implore the Holy Spirit to guide the people of God.

We'll remember all your deceased family and friends at each Mass in November.

On Saturday, November 2 at the 5:00 p.m. we will recall the members of our Parish who have died since the last All Souls' Day.

The annual All Souls' Day Mass will be celebrated at Holy Sepulchre Cemetery on Sunday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2024 at 2:00 p.m.

Those who wish to arrange Masses for deceased loved ones for 2025 may contact our Parish Office beginning November 1st.

#### CATHOLIC RITES OF BURIAL

Catholics have a tradition of honouring the bodies of the deceased that goes back to the earliest days of the Church. Our human body is the earthly dwelling of the Holy Spirit and our reverence for the body is a sign of our belief in the Resurrection in the fullness of time.

There are three "stations" in the Catholic funeral rite:

**Vigil of the Deceased** – gathering for prayer – usually the day before the Funeral.

**Funeral Mass** – celebrated in the presence of the deceased with their family and friends. We offer our worship to God and offer thanks for His life shining through the life of our loved one.

**Burial** – after the Funeral the body is buried in a cemetery or mausoleum accompanied by our prayer.
