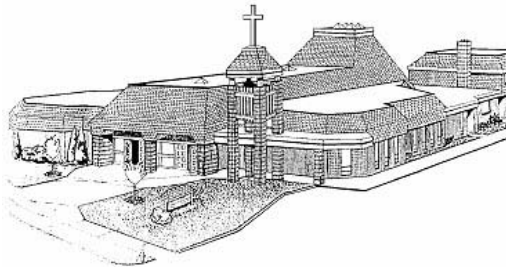

CARTA ENCICLICA (ECCLESIA DE EUCHARISTIA) DEL SUMO PONTIFICE JUAN PABLO II SOBRE LA EUCHARISTIA EN SU RELACION CON LA IGLESIA

5. «*Mysterium fidei!* – ¡Misterio de la fe!»». Cuando el sacerdote pronuncia o canta estas palabras, los presentes aclaman: «Anunciamos tu muerte, proclamamos tu resurrección, ¡ven Señor Jesús!».

Con éstas o parecidas palabras, la Iglesia, a la vez que se refiere a Cristo en el misterio de su Pasión, *revela también su propio misterio: Ecclesia de Eucharistia*. Si con el don del Espíritu Santo en Pentecostés la Iglesia nace y se encamina por las vías del mundo, un momento decisivo de su formación es ciertamente la institución de la Eucaristía en el Cenáculo. Su fundamento y su hontanar es todo el *Triduum paschale*, pero éste está como incluido, anticipado, y «concentrado» para siempre en el don eucarístico. En este don, Jesucristo entregaba a la Iglesia la actualización perenne del misterio pascual. Con él instituyó una misteriosa «contemporaneidad» entre aquel *Triduum* y el transcurrir de todos los siglos.

Este pensamiento nos lleva a sentimientos de gran asombro y gratitud. El acontecimiento pascual y la Eucaristía que lo actualiza a lo largo de los siglos tienen una «capacidad» verdaderamente enorme, en la que entra toda la historia como destinataria de la gracia de la redención. Este asombro ha de inundar siempre a la Iglesia, reunida en la celebración eucarística. Pero, de modo especial, debe acompañar al ministro de la Eucaristía. En efecto, es él quien, gracias a la facultad concedida por el sacramento del Orden sacerdotal, realiza la consagración. Con la potestad que le viene del Cristo del Cenáculo, dice: «Esto es mi cuerpo, que será entregado por vosotros... Éste es el cáliz de mi sangre, que será derramada por vosotros». El sacerdote pronuncia estas palabras o, más bien, *pone su boca y su voz a disposición de Aquél que las pronunció en el Cenáculo* y quiso que fueran repetidas de generación en generación por todos los que en la Iglesia participan ministerialmente de su sacerdocio.

ENCYCLICAL LETTER (ECCLESIA DE EUCHARISTIA) OF HIS HOLINESS POPE JOHN PAUL II ON THE EUCHARIST IN ITS RELATIONSHIP TO THE CHURCH



5. “*Mysterium fidei!* - The Mystery of Faith!”. When the priest recites or chants these words, all present acclaim: “We announce your death, O Lord, and we proclaim your resurrection, until you come in glory”. In these or similar words the Church, while pointing to Christ in the mystery of his passion, *also reveals her own mystery: Ecclesia de Eucharistia*. By the gift of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost the Church was born and set out upon the pathways of the world, yet a decisive moment in her taking shape was certainly the institution of the Eucharist in the Upper Room. Her foundation and wellspring is the whole *Triduum paschale*, but this is as if it were gathered up, foreshadowed and “concentrated” for ever in the gift of the Eucharist. In this gift Jesus Christ entrusted to his Church the perennial making present of the paschal mystery. With it he brought about a mysterious “oneness in time” between that *Triduum* and the passage of the centuries.

The thought of this leads us to profound amazement and gratitude. In the paschal event and the Eucharist which makes it present throughout the centuries, there is a truly enormous “capacity” which embraces all of history as the recipient of the grace of the redemption. This amazement should always fill the Church assembled for the celebration of the Eucharist. But in a special way it should fill the minister of the Eucharist. For it is he who, by the authority given him in the sacrament of priestly ordination, effects the consecration. It is he who says with the power coming to him from Christ in the Upper Room: “This is my body which will be given up for you This is the cup of my blood, poured out for you...”. The priest says these words, or rather *he puts his voice at the disposal of the One who spoke these words in the Upper Room* and who desires that they should be repeated in every generation by all those who in the Church ministerially share in his priesthood.
