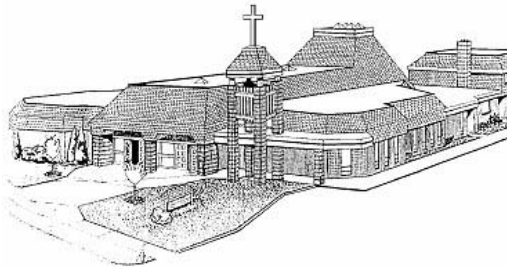

- The parish office will only contact you about a mass request if we **CANNOT** fulfill it; so, if you left a request in the intention box **2 WEEKS IN ADVANCE** you will only be contacted if the date you requested is **UNAVAILABLE**, otherwise consider the mass request fulfilled.

CARTA ENCICLICA (ECCLESIA DE EUCHARISTIA) DEL SUMO PONTIFICE JUAN PABLO II SOBRE LA EUCARISTIA EN SU RELACION CON LA IGLESIA

7. Desde que inicié mi ministerio de Sucesor de Pedro, he reservado siempre para el Jueves Santo, día de la Eucaristía y del Sacerdocio, un signo de particular atención, dirigiendo una carta a todos los sacerdotes del mundo. Este año, para mí el vigésimo quinto de Pontificado, deseo involucrar más plenamente a toda la Iglesia en esta reflexión eucarística, para dar gracias a Dios también por el don de la Eucaristía y del Sacerdocio: «Don y misterio». Puesto que, proclamando el año del Rosario, he deseado poner este mi vigésimo quinto año *bajo el signo de la contemplación de Cristo con María*, no puedo dejar pasar este Jueves Santo de 2003 sin detenerme ante el rostro eucarístico de Cristo, señalando con nueva fuerza a la Iglesia la centralidad de la Eucaristía. De ella vive la Iglesia. De este «pan vivo» se alimenta. ¿Cómo no sentir la necesidad de exhortar a todos a que hagan de ella siempre una renovada experiencia?

ENCYCLICAL LETTER (ECCLESIA DE EUCHARISTIA) OF HIS HOLINESS POPE JOHN PAUL II ON THE EUCHARIST IN ITS RELATIONSHIP TO THE CHURCH



7. From the time I began my ministry as the Successor of Peter, I have always marked Holy Thursday, the day of the Eucharist and of the priesthood, by sending a letter to all the priests of the world. This year, the twenty-fifth of my Pontificate, I wish to involve the whole Church more fully in this Eucharistic reflection, also as a way of thanking the Lord for the gift of the Eucharist and the priesthood: “Gift and Mystery”.⁴ By proclaiming the Year of the Rosary, I wish to put this, my twenty-fifth anniversary, *under the aegis of the contemplation of Christ at the school of Mary*. Consequently, I cannot let this Holy Thursday 2003 pass without halting before the “Eucharistic face” of Christ and pointing out with new force to the Church the centrality of the Eucharist.

From it the Church draws her life. From this “living bread” she draws her nourishment. How could I not feel the need to urge everyone to experience it ever anew?


