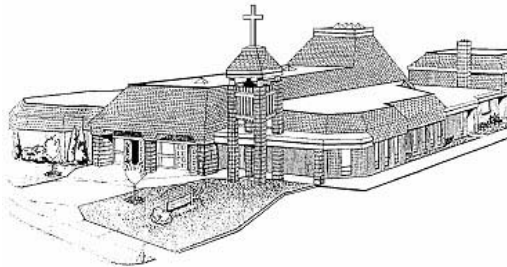

Una vez que haya colocado la ofrenda en el sobre (\$10), séllelo y colóquelo en la cajita de madera, que se ha fijado a la mesa en la parte posterior de la iglesia (detrás de la última banca).

CARTA ENCICLICA (ECCLESIA DE EUCHARISTIA) DEL SUMO PONTIFICE JUAN PABLO II SOBRE LA EUCARISTIA EN SU RELACION CON LA IGLESIA

4. *La hora de nuestra redención.* Jesús, aunque sometido a una prueba terrible, no huye ante su «hora»: «¿Qué voy a decir? ¡Padre, librame de esta hora! Pero ¡si he llegado a esta hora para esto!» (Jn 12, 27). Desea que los discípulos le acompañen y, sin embargo, debe experimentar la soledad y el abandono: «¿Conque no habéis podido velar una hora conmigo? Velad y orad, para que no caigáis en tentación» (Mt 26, 40-41). Sólo Juan permanecerá al pie de la Cruz, junto a María y a las piadosas mujeres. La agonía en Getsemaní ha sido la introducción a la agonía de la Cruz del Viernes Santo. *La hora santa*, la hora de la redención del mundo. Cuando se celebra la Eucaristía ante la tumba de Jesús, en Jerusalén, se retorna de modo casi tangible a su «hora», la hora de la cruz y de la glorificación. A aquel lugar y a aquella hora vuelve espiritualmente todo presbítero que celebra la Santa Misa, junto con la comunidad cristiana que participa en ella.

«Fue crucificado, muerto y sepultado, descendió a los infiernos, al tercer día resucitó de entre los muertos». A las palabras de la profesión de fe hacen eco las palabras de la contemplación y la proclamación: «*Ecce lignum crucis in quo salus mundi pependit. Venite adoremus*» (Este es el madero de la Cruz, de la que pendió el salvador del mundo. Venid, adoremos). Ésta es la invitación que la Iglesia hace a todos en la tarde del Viernes Santo. Y hará de nuevo uso del canto durante el tiempo pascual para proclamar: «*Surrexit Dominus de sepulcro qui pro nobis pependit in ligno. Aleluya*» (El Señor ha resucitado del sepulcro; por nosotros fue colgado en la Cruz, Aleluya).

ENCYCLICAL LETTER (ECCLESIA DE EUCHARISTIA) OF HIS HOLINESS POPE JOHN PAUL II ON THE EUCHARIST IN ITS RELATIONSHIP TO THE CHURCH



4. *The hour of our redemption.* Although deeply troubled, Jesus does not flee before his “hour”. “And what shall I say? ‘Father, save me from this hour?’ No, for this purpose I have come to this hour” (Jn 12:27). He wanted his disciples to keep him company, yet he had to experience loneliness and abandonment: “So, could you not watch with me one hour? Watch and pray that you may not enter into temptation” (Mt 26:40- 41). Only John would remain at the foot of the Cross, at the side of Mary and the faithful women. The agony in Gethsemane was the introduction to the agony of the Cross on Good Friday. *The holy hour*, the hour of the redemption of the world. Whenever the Eucharist is celebrated at the tomb of Jesus in Jerusalem, there is an almost tangible return to his “hour”, the hour of his Cross and glorification. Every priest who celebrates Holy Mass, together with the Christian community which takes part in it, is led back in spirit to that place and that hour.

“*He was crucified, he suffered death and was buried; he descended to the dead; on the third day he rose again*”. The words of the profession of faith are echoed by the words of contemplation and proclamation: “*This is the wood of the Cross, on which hung the Saviour of the world. Come, let us worship*”. This is the invitation which the Church extends to all in the afternoon hours of Good Friday. She then takes up her song during the Easter season in order to proclaim: “*The Lord is risen from the tomb; for our sake he hung on the Cross, Alleluia*”.
