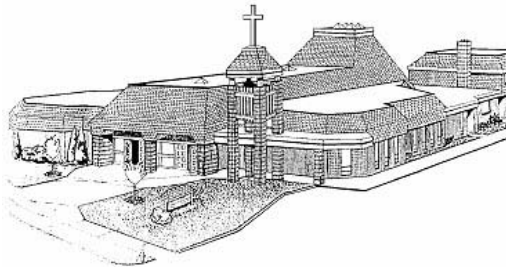

MASS INTENIONS:

- Please use Mass Intention Envelopes, and place them in the Mass Intention box or collection basket, to request and/or give an offering for a Mass intention, or through the parish website or email the office.
- When using an intention envelope, please place it in the **MASS INTENTION BOX** at the back of the Church, right behind the last pew. If you place your Mass intention envelope in the collection basket, or any other boxes, the office may not receive it in time. The parish office needs **2 WEEKS notice** for a weekend intention.
- The parish office will only contact you about a mass request if we **CANNOT** fulfill it; so, if you left a request in the intention box **2 WEEKS IN ADVANCE** you will only be contacted if the date you requested is **UNAVAILABLE**, otherwise consider the mass request fulfilled.

DONATING TO THE PARISH:

CARTA ENCICLICA (ECCLESIA DE EUCHARISTIA) DEL SUMO PONTIFICE JUAN PABLO II SOBRE LA EUCARISTIA EN SU RELACION CON LA IGLESIA

2. Durante el Gran Jubileo del año 2000, tuve ocasión de celebrar la Eucaristía en el Cenáculo de Jerusalén, donde, según la tradición, fue realizada la primera vez por Cristo mismo. *El Cenáculo es el lugar de la institución de este Santísimo Sacramento.* Allí Cristo tomó en sus manos el pan, lo partió y lo dio a los discípulos diciendo: «Tomad y comed todos de él, porque esto es mi Cuerpo, que será entregado por vosotros» (cf. *Mt 26, 26; Lc 22, 19; 1 Co 11, 24*). Después tomó en sus manos el cáliz del vino y les dijo: «Tomad y bebed todos de él, porque éste es el cáliz de mi sangre, sangre de la alianza nueva y eterna, que será derramada por vosotros y por todos los hombres para el perdón de los pecados» (cf. *Mt 14, 24; Lc 22, 20; 1 Co 11, 25*). Estoy agradecido al Señor Jesús que me permitió repetir en aquel mismo lugar, obedeciendo su mandato «haced esto en conmemoración mía» (*Lc 22, 19*), las palabras pronunciadas por Él hace dos mil años.

Los Apóstoles que participaron en la Última Cena, ¿comprendieron el sentido de las palabras que salieron de los labios de Cristo? Quizás no. Aquellas palabras se habrían aclarado plenamente sólo al final del *Triduum sacrum*, es decir, el lapso que va de la tarde del jueves hasta la mañana del domingo. En esos días se enmarca el *mysterium paschale*; en ellos se inscribe también el *mysterium eucharisticum*.

ENCYCLICAL LETTER (ECCLESIA DE EUCHARISTIA) OF HIS HOLINESS POPE JOHN PAUL II ON THE EUCHARIST IN ITS RELATIONSHIP TO THE CHURCH



2. During the Great Jubilee of the Year 2000 I had an opportunity to celebrate the Eucharist in the Cenacle of Jerusalem where, according to tradition, it was first celebrated by Jesus himself. *The Upper Room was where this most holy Sacrament was instituted.* It is there that Christ took bread, broke it and gave it to his disciples, saying: "Take this, all of you, and eat it: this is my body which will be given up for you" (cf. *Mt 26:26; Lk 22:19; 1 Cor 11:24*). Then he took the cup of wine and said to them: "Take this, all of you and drink from it: this is the cup of my blood, the blood of the new and everlasting covenant. It will be shed for you and for all, so that sins may be forgiven" (cf. *Mt 14:24; Lk 22:20; 1 Cor 11:25*). I am grateful to the Lord Jesus for allowing me to repeat in that same place, in obedience to his command: "Do this in memory of me" (*Lk 22:19*), the words which he spoke two thousand years ago. Did the Apostles who took part in the Last Supper understand the meaning of the words spoken by Christ? Perhaps not. Those words would only be fully clear at the end of the *Triduum sacrum*, the time from Thursday evening to Sunday morning. Those days embrace the *mysterium paschale*; they also embrace the *mysterium eucharisticum*.

THE FOURTH WORLD DAY TO CELEBRATE GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY is **July 28th, 2024**. This special Day, initiated by Pope Francis, is a precious opportunity to value grandparents and the elderly in our local communities. This year's theme, "**Do not cast me off in my old age**" (Ps 71:9), highlights the loneliness experienced by many elderly people. In response, we need to encourage people to visit them, especially those who are isolated. In a world that increasingly sends a message that the elderly do not matter, we are called to let them know they do and that we recognize their worth.
