

### A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR:

His Sunday, instead of celebrating the Fourth Sunday of Ordinary Time, we celebrate the beautiful Feast of the Presentation of Our Lord.

In regard to this calendar year, it is unique because we have five different Feast Days which override the Ordinary Time Sundays. They include St. Peter and St. Paul on June 29<sup>th</sup>. We then celebrate the Exaltation of the Holy Cross on September 14<sup>th</sup>. Next, we celebrate two Feast Days in a row in November. The first is the Feast of All Souls on November 2<sup>nd</sup>, followed by The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica on November 9<sup>th</sup>.

This number of Feast Days on Sundays is a nice change for us, because it allows for us to see different elements of our Catholic faith. This includes the images of great saints. There is the Passion of the Cross and the hope for the Resurrection of all who believe.

My thoughts on the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord are through my first appointment as a priest back in 1995. My first assignment was at Blessed Sacrament Church in Kitchener. Up on the sanctuary, to the right of the altar, there is a beautiful statue carved from wood of the Holy Family presenting themselves at the Temple.

The figures of the statue are life sized, and the details are simply amazing. The statue was created by a parishioner of Blessed Sacrament Parish. What caught my attention was the wooden cage which St. Joseph held in his one hand. It is the image of two doves and once again the details are amazing. This statue and its beauty made me want to learn more about this Feast Day.

Luke, in our passage presents us with a family that is pious, very involved in their religious tradition, extremely faith-filled and faithful. Luke tells us of the Family that follows the law of circumcision, purification for a mother who has given birth, and made presentation of their firstborn Son to the Lord as directed in the Scriptures.

The accepted offering for purification of a family after a birth was a year-old lamb and either one dove or a pigeon. If the family was poor, they could offer two birds. Luke tells us, then, that not only was

the family very faithful, but they were a family which identified with the poor.

This Feast Day gives us a choice to make. We can be like the faithful Jewish parents who took their faith seriously enough to make a return to the Lord of the most precious thing in their lives, that is, their Son, whom they presented to God in the Temple. Or do we have the attitude not to return the gifts and blessings which God has given us in our lives? This is a challenge for all of us in the lives in which we live.
