

### A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR:

ith this Sunday, we return to Ordinary Time in the Church's liturgical year. We also have an extended period of Ordinary Time this year because Lent and Easter are later than usual. We will celebrate some Sundays in Ordinary Time this year that we seldom have an opportunity to celebrate.

The Second Sunday in Ordinary Time gives us the beautiful story of the wedding at Cana in Galilee. We see Jesus performing His first miracle. However, there is more to His action of changing barrels of water into vats of wine than appears at first sight. He is not merely saving a couple of newlyweds from public shame because their wine is running short. What He is really doing is speaking to each one of us personally about the shortages in our own lives.

On this Sunday we must see that Christ is the spirit of new life continually bursting into a world that is weary of meaningless living. The Gospel of John is telling us that we need to be refreshed, to let Christ touch the water of our lives and bring greater understanding.

We might be surprised at how Jesus refused His Mother but ultimately, He did take upon Himself the responsibility to fix the situation. Why? John's Gospel is telling us something about God's relationship with us. Jesus did not perform a miracle because He was asked, even if asked by His Mother. Jesus performed the miracle because that was what He wanted to do. It was not the request that moved Jesus, it was His desire to assist us in our lives. In this case it was only to rescue a groom who had not fully prepared for his guests, but it serves as an example that not only can God help us, but that God wants to help us.

There is another beautiful image which we can take from this Gospel passage. The jars in the story were for Jewish ceremonial washings. The water that had been contained in them was to wash the hands, faces, and feet of the guests, an act of hospitality to help the guests purify themselves. The wine from these jars was a sign of an even better purification when God's people would be washed by the Blood of Christ.

The 'hour' Jesus spoke of was His Crucifixion and He wasn't ready for this yet. However, with the

miracle at Cana, John is telling us that our relationship with God was already changing because Jesus was now among us. This is a belief which we must carry throughout this Ordinary Time.
