THE BIBLE TIMELINE - Faith Study with Jeff Cavins Join us for Part 1 of EARLY WORLD on Monday Nov 04 in the hall at 7pm or Tuesday Nov 05 at 9am upstairs. The Bible is not a science book, so we need to take into account the ways the ancient Hebrews viewed history and wrote it. They weren't all about "the facts" the way we understand facts. The Catechism tells us that the first three chapters of Genesis, were placed at the start of the Bible "to express in their solemn language the truths of creation-its origin and its end in God, its order and goodness, the vocation of man, and finally the drama of sin and the hope of salvation". Read in the light of Christ, within the unity of Sacred Scripture and in the living Tradition of the Church, these texts remain the principal source for catechesis on the mysteries of the 'beginning': creation, fall, and promise of salvation.
