MISSION APPEAL: DIOCESE OF ZARIA

Weekend of August 17/18

The coming mission appeal in St. Basil's Parish is to raise awareness of the plight of the vulnerable population in the diocese of Zaria who live on the margin of society, who cannot afford necessities of life such as food, medicine, water and clothing. Through our diocesan office of Justice and Peace, they have identified such families at parish levels and have helped to alleviate their humanitarian concerns. However, the number of people in dire need have been on the increase. The recent onslaught of the extremist Islamic sect, Boko Haram, and the heinous activities of kidnappers and bandits have exacerbated the problem. Many families continue to flee conflicts zones, leaving vast uncultivated lands that hitherto had served as source of livelihood.
