

STOP AND SMELL THE ROSES

"So they went with haste and found Mary and Joseph, and the child lying in the manger. When they saw this, they made known what had been told them about this child; and all who heard it were amazed at what the shepherds told them. But Mary treasured all these words and pondered them in her heart." (Luke 2.16-19)

There is a great German carol *Es Ist Ein Ros*, whose first line in English is "Lo, how a rose e'er blooming", or the lesser known "A Spotless Rose is blowing,". Within Mary the root of the rose is said to be growing. In English, we infer the rose is Jesus, sprung up from the root of Jesse, making reference to Isaiah 11.1: "A shoot shall come out from the stump of Jesse, and a branch shall grow out of his roots." In the original German however, the rose is Mary, making reference to Galatians 2.1: "I am a rose of Sharon, a lily of the valleys."

Our Gospel reading on the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God is also heard on Christmas day this year. In it, Mary pauses and treasurers the news from the shepherds. Having just delivered a baby, she's likely exhausted both mentally and physically when strangers show up and share with her the news from the angels. I can imagine that privacy and safety where among the primary concerns for Mary and Joseph when they settled for the evening in the stable. Amidst all this chaos, Mary welcomed the news from the shepherds the same way she welcomed the news from Gabriel at the Annunciation: with a quiet receptiveness. We too must have the courage to hear the messages God has for us amidst the chaos.


