Join to pray with the hand-illuminated images and text of the St. John's Bible using Ignatian tools for prayer. Regis College is privileged to own one of the 299 fascimiles of the St. John's Bible, the first complete Bible to be scribed and illuminated by hand in more than 400 years. The original combines medieval artistic techniques with contemporary theological reflection in a visual medium. Open to young adults (18-39 years old). The night will begin with a talk about the St. John's Bible, the passage selected, and an Ignatian tool of prayer. Then, there will be a time of prayer with the Scripture passage in adoration in the Regis College Chapel. The night will then conclude with a social in the Student Lounge.

WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY

The Church is preparing to celebrate the third World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly on Sunday, 23 July. The Church observes the World Day each year on the fourth Sunday in July, close to the feast of Jesus' grandparents, Saints Joachim and Anne.

Pope Francis instituted this Day in 2021 since, he believes grandparents "are the link between generations, passing on the experience of life and faith to the young." Pope Francis chose as this year's theme "His mercy is from age to age" (Luke 1.50), which expresses the link with World Youth Day, 1-6 August 2023, which takes place shortly thereafter in Lisbon, Portugal.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (R.C.I.A.)

Are you or someone you know interested in joining the Catholic faith? The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, or R.C.I.A., is the process by which:

- A person who is not a baptized Christian can become Roman Catholic;
- A person who is baptized in another Christian denomination can be received into the Roman Catholic Church; or
- A person who was baptized in the Roman Catholic Church can complete their initiation through the sacrament of Confirmation.
