## THE DEAD SEA SCROLLS AND JEWISH-CHRISTIAN DIALOGUE

The renowned annual fall lecture of the Bernardin Center at the Catholic Theological Union in Chicago will this year focus on the significance of the Dead Sea Scrolls for Jewish-Catholic dialogue. Dr. Lawrence H. Schiffman, the Judge Abraham Lieberman Professor of Hebrew and Judaic Studies and Director of the Global Institute for Advanced Research in Jewish Studies at New York University, will explore how the discovery and study of these ancient scrolls marks a turning point in understanding biblical history and offer great potential for dialogue today. Plan to attend this virtual event packed with insights on the emerging consensus in interpretation between Jewish and Christian scholars and their impressive witness of collaboration that has fostered the publication of entire corpus of the scrolls. These and other developments are a testimony to the ongoing progress of mutual understanding between our respective faith communities.

#### VIRTUAL LECTURE: CHOSING HOPE

In this lecture, Dr. David Arnow, a writer, clinical psychologist, and activist in the Jewish community will delve into the depths of the reservoir of hope from Biblical times to the present day. Explore the fundamental sources of hope which have helped the Jewish people stay strong and optimistic through the challenges of life. These sources include: Teshuvah (a method to fulfill hope), Tikkun olam (the hope that we can repair the world by working together), Abraham and Sarah (models persisting in hope amid trials), Exodus (an archetype of redemptive hope), Covenant (the hope for a durable relationship with God), Job (the "hardfought hope" that brings a grief-stricken man back to life), the World-to-Come (the sustaining hope that death is not the end), as well as Humour.
