

#### PASTORAL CARE

**BAPTISMS** - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

**CONFESSIONS** - By appointment only.

**MARRIAGES** - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING - By appointment.

## SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

#### <u>DISPENSATION TO ATTEND SUNDAY MASS LIFTED</u> AS OF APRIL 9<sup>TH</sup>:

When the Covid pandemic began more than two years ago, all Catholics in the Archdiocese of Ottawa-Carleton were freed from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days. Through the magic of technology we were able to "participate" in Mass on our screens and devices. Technology kept us connected even if in a very limited way. However, livestreamed masses were a temporary alternative. With social distancing requirements and mask mandates lifted, the dispensation from attending Sunday Mass will be lifted as of April 9th , the Palm Sunday Vigil Mass. Those who cannot attend Mass because of age, sickness, disability or other grave reasons would still be excused, as always. The Mass is the source and summit of our Catholic faith. It is where we gather as a community to hear God's words and where we truly meet Jesus in the Eucharist. Come back to Mass He is waiting for you and so are we.

### <u>A MESSAGE FROM FR. JOBE</u>

Peace and all good!

As we begin Holy Week on Palm Sunday, our joy is full when Jesus makes his entrance into Jerusalem and the crowds acclaim Him as their King and Messiah. Let us also claim Him as our personal Lord and Saviour.

Like the prophet Isaiah, Jesus does not turn His back, He does not flinch before the enemy (1st Reading). Accepting the will of the Father, He is willing to empty Himself, taking the form of a slave for our salvation (2nd Reading). We are progressively saddened as we hear the narrative of the Passion of Our Lord and we even wonder why Jesus had to die such a cruel death.

In one of the most beautiful Lenten readings of the Church's Liturgy of the Hours (Office of Readings), St. Aelred's work, Mirror of Love, identifies Christ as the model of brotherly love. Jesus does not only show His enemies mercy and forgiveness in the prayer, "Father, forgive them." The Lord goes even further by making excuses for them and their lack of judgment in not recognizing His glory that is hidden from them. Jesus simply prays, "Father, they do not know what they are doing." As our joy today is full, so also let our love be full as we follow the example of Jesus' sacrificial love for all of us.
